### Little Dragons Belt Grading Friday 5<sup>th</sup> May



We are looking forward to our next Belt Grading for our Little Dragons on Friday 5<sup>th</sup> May. The grading will be held during the normal class time and is an opportunity for ALL current Little Dragons to earn their new belt in Taekwondo! We would expect and encourage all Little Dragons to take part in the Belt Grading!

The presentation for new belts and certificates will be held at the end of the normal Little Dragons class on the following Friday 12<sup>th</sup> May.

The next Phoenix TKD grading on Sunday May 21st is fast approaching. There will be an external examiner and the grading standard is expected to be high, especially for our more advanced belt grades. Therefore we will be arranging two Grading Workshops for intermediate to high grade Junior students currently at Green Belt or above.

3.30pm-4.00pm: Grading for Blue Stripe / Blue Belt (current Green Belts & Blue Stripes)

These grading workshops will provide an extremely valuable opportunity to be fully prepared for the Grading Examination and we strongly encourage all our Junior students at these grades who wish to do the grading to attend the appropriate session, as it will offer significant insight into what is required to pass the grading and the opportunity to work intensively in a small group of similar grades.

## The Phoenix Taekwondo **Spring Grading Examination**

The Phoenix Taekwondo Spring Grading for all Junior and Senior students will be held on Sunday 21st May. For this grading we again will have an external examiner with many years of Taekwondo experience to evaluate our students. Given the large number of students expected to enter the Grading Examination, the actual examination day will be spread out over 4 individual grading events. Students will only be required to attend the time for their specific

15:40 - 16:45 - All Seniors grading for Yellow Stripe - Red Belt (current White Belts - Red Stripes).

16:50 – 17:30 - Juniors and Seniors grading for Black Stripe (current Red Belts).

As with every grading, a pass is obviously not guaranteed and as usual students must be able to complete the relevant patterns for each grade correctly and with power. Obviously a higher standard is expected from our more advanced grade students (i.e., grading for Blue Belt and above).
