### **ELEMENTS STAGE SHOW INFORMATION**

Please read carefully the information below about rehearsals up to the Elements show and the performance night.

Full Dress Rehearsal: Sunday 8th May 3:00pm-5:00pm @ Phoenix Sunday Venue Manor School, OX11 7LB:

We will be holding a full Dress Rehearsal, running through all scenes in order with music.

Little Dragons are NOT required for this rehearsal.

Juniors Parents please drop off and pick up (we prefer not to have spectators).

We expect to see ALL students from ALL classes (except Little Dragons) to participate at this Dress Rehearsal.

#### Full Technical/Dress Rehearsal Saturday 14th May: 1:00pm-3:00pm @ Amey Theatre:

We will run through the entire show including lighting and effects on the stage from 1pm at the Amey Theatre.

This is for ALL students, including Little Dragons, Juniors and Seniors.

#### Little Dragons – what to wear to BOTH Tech/Dress Rehearsal and Performance:

Little Dragons should come wearing their Little Dragons T-shirt, belt and black track bottoms (+named water bottle). During the show, when not on stage, the Little Dragons will be sat and supervised in the rear seats of the theatre.

#### Junior and Senior members – what to wear to BOTH Tech/Dress Rehearsal and Performance:

Please arrive in full dobok, belt and club hoodie if you have one (+named water bottle).

We will be filming at both the Dress Rehearsal and the actual performance, so NO T-shirts please just doboks.

We discourage the use of tablets/phones, etc by the Juniors on the day (and take no responsibility for any loss).
