This included a session learning Ilyeo - the highest Taekwondo Pattern (that's pattern number 17). It is fantastic to make and maintain these connections and feedback the valuable education to our own club and students

Taekwondo Dongmeng Group Dan Seminar: Getting an Early Start on the Road to Black Belt



Phoenix Taekwondo are one of the founding member clubs of the Taekwondo Dongmeng group, an Alliance of British Taekwondo clubs organising national level examinations for Black Belt. The preparation for these Dan Examinations is very intense and some of this years candidates got an early start on the preparation, making the long trip over to Boston, Lincolnshire for a FIVE HOUR Seminar. The seminar drew over 60 participants from all over the country to learn from the Taekwondo Grandmasters and Masters who will make up the actual examination panel for the Grading. Black Belt candidates Abi, Advita and Lucia sacrificing their last day of the Easter Holidays received instruction from the 8th Dan Black Belt Grandmasters - a hard session but a fantastic experience. Kit joined the high Dan group working through the advanced syllabus and Phoenix instructor Chris, as one of the Examination Panel himself was one of the panel coaches.
