Following the recent Black Belt success of Phoenix TKD's Owen, last month we





Taekwondo Sport Sparring: Understanding the Referee



With the delivery of a large number of body protectors, many of you may have noticed that we have started to build more Taekwondo sport sparring into our Senior and Advanced Junior classes.

In our February newsletter we explained the scoring system for Taekwondo but it is also vital to understand the different referee commands and signals and how a competition round is started and finished. Sparring is started with the normal *charyot* + *kyungye*, however the command junbi has a different meaning than normal and opponents should jump into fighting stance ready to begin (with the command

shijak). If the referee wishes to pause the sparring at any time, they will say - Galyeo - and then - Gyesok - to resume. At the end of the round the referee will shout - Geuman - that means stop!
