# International Black Belt Certification Award for Phoenix Students Delivered from the World Taekwondo Kukkiwon Headquarters in Korea



Last month we celebrated the first batch of our official Black Belt Kukkiwon Certificates delivered from Korea - The Kukkiwon - the Headquarters of Taekwondo in the world! Passing the national level Dan (Black Belt) Examination is not quite the end of the story for our aspiring Black Belts, as after passing the grading, all successful applications are passed on to British Taekwondo, the National Governing Body for Taekwondo in the UK. British Taekwondo will then apply directly to the Kukkiwon Headquarters out in Seoul, South Korea to process all

applications and issue the official Kukkiwon sanctioned Black Belt certification. This certification is a world recognised award, and goes far beyond a local club certificate. The process does however take some time and the certification is often received months after the original examination so we have to be patient. All Black Belts receive a large, beautiful certificate and an associated Kukkiwon ID card, with their unique certificate number. In all, we expect 33 Certificates for our latest cohort of Black Belts, delivered or soon on their way! Congratulations to all our Black Belts on their world recognised Taekwondo certification!
