
Celebrating New Belts for all our Little Dragons

Given the large number of students expected to enter the Grading Examination, the actual examination day will be spread out over 4 individual grading events. 15:40 – 16:45 - All Seniors grading for Yellow Stripe – Red Belt (current White Belts - Red Stripes).

16:50 – 17:30 - Juniors and Seniors grading for Black Stripe (current Red Belts).

As with every grading, a pass is obviously not guaranteed and as usual students must be able to complete the relevant patterns for each grade correctly and with power. Obviously a higher standard is expected from our more advanced grade students (i.e., grading for Blue Belt and above). However, it will be a great chance for everyone to show their Taekwondo off to an independent examiner and a great accolade if successful!

Successful students will receive their new Taekwondo Belt and official National Certificate at the Grading Presentation Ceremony to be held at the normal class on Friday 24th November from 7pm towards the end of the Beginner Junior class.
